
WANT TO INCREASE YOUR SALES AND ATTENDANCE?

King BMX Stunt Shows is proven entertainment for kids and adults alike. Each show is staffed with professional riders that have competed in events like the X Games and Gravity Games. Every performance features high-flying aerial stunts and mind boggling technical maneuvers executed on the ground.

All shows are choreographed to clean music and hosted by a high-energy announcer who will connect the audience with all rides and stunts. Most importantly, these bicycle stunt shows are proven to increase attendance and sales at your event.







The King BMX Stunt Team will provide a High Energy 25- 30 minute Bike Stunt Show consisting of both flatland and ramp stunts. The show is fully self-contained and the team will bring their own sound system and ramps.

All that you need to provide is a large level riding area (asphalt or concrete) that measures approximately 35' x 125'. In some cases a 110 outlet will be required. The rest will be taken care of by the team.



most difficult aspect of the sport. Riders will amaze you with their incredible balance and their ability to seamlessly transition from one trick to another. Flatland can be performed on any level dry surface. It is a huge festival or parade attention draw.

RAMPS (Aerial Stunts) will amaze crowds when riders do 360 degree turns in the air and back flips by the dozens. Quarter pipes and box jumps are typical ramps used in the action packed bike stunt show.





LEVEL ONE

the most common set up for one-day events and is transported in a single truck. set up time is one hour.

LEVEL TWO

used at county fairs and requires 2 trucks. set up time is one day.

only used at the NC state fair. requires an 18 wheeler and both show trailers. set up time is 2 days.
